The NZ Harlequins Clubrooms Montage



The name Harlequins and logo

The Hampstead Football Club held a meeting at the beginning of the 1869-70 season, during which it was decided to change the name of Hampstead FC as the membership was no longer a purely local one. At the same time it was unanimously agreed that it would be a great pity to dispense with the 'HFC' monogram and the 'Nunquam Dormio' motto already in use, so a dictionary was procured and the 'H's' read out. When the reader got to 'Harlequin' he was stopped, all present at once signifying their approval. At that same meeting, instead of the old Hampstead black and gold, the new colours chosen were light blue, magenta, chocolate, French grey, light green, and black.

With this dictionary origin in mind, let us look at just three of the various definitions and descriptions of 'Harlequin' as they appear in books of reference: (1) a character in traditional pantomime, (2) a person who makes funny moves, and (3) a waggish trickster. Here, surely, is food for thought. Has the club's style of football been influenced by the 'Harlequin' name and its meanings? Do not these dictionary definitions give some kind of a clue to the methods, the unorthodoxy, the snapping-up of a half-chance, the attacks launched from anywhere, the 'Harlequin' game?



The original logo of the our New Zealand based Harlequins Club was used on programmes until the late 60's. The logo used on the Harlequins jerseys until the 60's, it had a Bull with an H in a Shield, this was embroidered on the right side of the chest. From the late 60's until the early 90s' the NZ Harlequins used only their unique colours for identification. From the late 1980's the NZ Harelquin Club started using their new logo embroidered on the left side, on the magenta patch of the jersey.
